The Point System

During the course of the internship project, you will be evaluated on a point system. For each department there is a total of **100 points**. In order to successfully complete the internship you must earn a minimum of **70 points** in each workshop to pass. The coordinators of each working department will also offer different ways to attain extra credit points if you are absent for certain workshop(s). These points are earned on a per department basis and the terms must be arranged through the coordinator whose workshop you are unable to attend.

Terms and Conditions

In deciding to participate in this project, you must abide by the following conditions:

- 1. Participation in the internship project grants an **exemption** from a midterm, paper, or assignment **OR extra credit** for up to **two participating AAS or ETHS classes** (**it is under the discretion of the professor on what extra credit or exemption they offer you)
- 2. If the above option is not chosen, the internship project can grant **three upper division Ethnic Studies units**. The internship can only be taken for a letter grade and withdrawal policies are the same as any other University class.
- 3. The project consists of seven different departments. Participation in every department is necessary, unless alternate arrangements are made with the Internship Coordinator.
- 4. Upon signing the contract, you agree to commit yourself to the internship project for the **entire 10-week project.**
- 5. Time outside of the regularly scheduled workshops is necessary on a per department basis.
- 6. Attendance at PACE GMs, community events and time outside of internship is highly recommended.
- 7. All assigned work from all syllabi must be completed.
- 8. First Hoorah will be held on **Sunday**, **February 10**, **2018 from 11am-3pm**. More information will be given via e-mail.
